# **Speakers for Upcoming Meetings**

### Replacement of the Split-Rail Fence

Judah has been working with Kate Mattos regarding the replacement of the splitrail fence. Kevin Stalica will be invited to come to the February 25 meeting and present the three replacement options for its replacement. The options will be posted on the BCA Website for review by BCA members prior to the meeting.

### **Peck-Staples and Jordan Manor Update**

Work has begun on the utilities at the Peck-Staples site. Some building supplies have been delivered, and a construction trailer has been set up. Jordan Manor demolition will begin on February 16 at the earliest. In the meantime, the site was used for some SWAT exercises, which scared the neighbors who had not been informed in advance. This made it impossible for plants to be removed safely. Wendy will ask Curtis Adams if neighbors can now proceed with plant removal.
