Call to Order and Attendance

She has enough 42-cent stamps for the next newsletter. Judah reminded everyone to complete the Wilson Boulevard commercial corridor survey on the BCA website and to remind our neighbors to do likewise. He also suggested that officers and representatives try to enlist replacements for BCA positions between now and the elections in 2010. David van Wagner will take over the task of newsletter distribution from Judy. Patrick Wegeng has placed flags and other markings for plantings along the bike path in Bluemont Park. Interested parties should make their comments to Patrick by May 16.

Bluemont Fundraiser

Judah wants to have a fundraising event between now and June 2010 that draws Arlington County residents to Bluemont. He envisions 100 to 200 people attending an event that includes music, food and alcohol. One of the challenges will be choosing the venue for this event.
