**Call to Order and Attendance**

President Judah dal Cais called the meeting to order at approximately 7:35 p.m. In attendance were Judah dal Cais, Mary Thorne, Judy Collins and Suzanne Sundburg.

**Approval of Minutes for 8/3/2010**

The Executive Board voted unanimously to approve the August 3, 2010, Executive Board meeting minutes. Thorne will forward the approved minutes for posting to the Bluemont Civic Association (BCA) Website.

**Upcoming Newsletters and Meetings**

The next two general meetings will be held on November 17 and January 19. Therefore the next two newsletters will be distributed in November and January. The remaining meeting dates for 2010-2011 will be decided at the December 15 Executive Board Meeting. Mary will provide attendance counts by month from past years as an aid to future planning. The March-June newsletters will be distributed in the months of general meetings and an electronic version will be available in 2011. Judah will ask Ritch Viola to speak on the master transportation plan at the November 17 meeting. BCA has a new police liaison who will also be invited to speak. New advertising policies and prices will also be covered at this meeting. Someone will give an update on the progress to date of the Neighborhood Conservation plan update. Suzanne Sundburg needs articles for the November newsletter on November 1. Judah will find a speaker to address the new budget for the January 19 meeting.

**Reports from Officers and Representatives**

The Liberty gas station, formerly known as D&V has received a cease and desist order for its rental truck business. Judah will follow up with Robbie Guenther for any further details. As the NC representative, Larry Smith is working on pushing through the project in the 1000 block of North Edison Street. A call for new projects is needed. Judy Collins reports that there are currently 288 members of BCA with some being paid through 2011. Judy and a couple of volunteers have been working on the edge development project in cooperation with Civic Federation Zoning Committee. Judah announced that a BCA representative is needed to attend meetings on the "beaver pond." Judah will circulate a petition to residents who live near the corner of North Florida Street and Bluemont Drive to obtain their support for construction of a bocce court. Judah will approach local restaurants and ask them to provide discounts/happy hours one night a week when they are traditionally not busy.

Suzanne reports that the Natural Resource Management Plan will be voted on at the County Board's November 13 meeting. Sundburg will buy and set up the BCA-sponsored snacks for Candidate's Night on October 28.
