Final Minutes
Executive Board Meeting
March 26, 2014
Arlington Traditional School

The regular monthly meeting of the Bluemont Civic Association (BCA) was held on Wednesday, March 26, 2014 the President being in the chair and the Secretary being present. A quorum was present.

The President called the meeting to order at 7:04 pm.

The minutes of the last meeting (February 26, 2014) were approved.

The Secretary asked the Board how to handle a charitable donation. The Board agreed that BCA should contact the donor to thank the donor, verify the donor's intentions, and inform the donor that a donation to BCA would not be tax deductible. The President took the donation with the envelope, so he could contact the donor.

The Secretary asked the Board what to do with documents sent to the President from the County concerning the Ashlawn School project. The Board said the documents should go to BCA's representative for the Ashlawn project. The Secretary said she would tell the general membership meeting about the documents BCA had received.

The President reported he had received a registered letter about a request from a neighbor on N. Illinois Street to divide his property. The Board agreed that because the immediate neighbors are informed of the request through the County system, and this is not a major project, BCA would not post the letter nor distribute it to BCA members. The Secretary was directed to keep the letter on file in case BCA members had questions or concerns about the project.

The President said he would ask the general membership meeting if any volunteers wanted to take charge of organizing a pot luck or similar event to mark Neighborhood Day.

The President adjourned the meeting at 7:28 PM
