- Lisa Maher, Planning Commission Coordinator in the County's Planning Division, briefed members on the basics of the planning process in Arlington. Maher advised the membership that Peck-Staples site developer JBG had indicated it would revise its plan to address some of the issues discussed at the previous Site Plan Review Committee (SPRC) meetings. The group also discussed proposed redevelopment of Jordan Manor Arlington Housing Corporation (AHC).
