- to have peace of mind when family members are far






Direct Services Provided by ANV Volunteers

 - 3,260+ services fulfilled in 2022
 - Drove 35,580+ miles
 - Donated 9,160+ hours
 - 96+% of requests fulfilled!
- Volunteers provide behind-the-scenes management expertise












