Background

Following an extensive public process last year, the County embarked on a demonstration project targeted at improvements to safety and accessibility for all modes of travel by restriping Wilson Boulevard from North Frederick to North Manchester Streets. A commitment was made to collect traffic data and also follow-up with the community to gain feedback on impacts of the demonstration project.

This section of Wilson Blvd. was repaved and restriped from four lanes to three lanes, including a center left turn lane throughout and added bike lanes on both sides.
