





### Examples of ANV Services

- Volunteer Help
  - Home maintenance
  - Errands & household chores
  - Transportation
  - Technology assistance
  - Daily check-in contact
- Referrals to county agency and other service providers

### ANV Service Delivery Process

- Single phone call or email to make a member service request
- Request matched with village volunteer
- Volunteer scheduled to deliver service
- Volunteer reports service completion
- Quality assurance follow-up with member

### ANV Membership Categories and Fees

- **Full Membership** entitles you to all programs and services \*\*
  - Individual fee is \$500 – less than \$10 per week
  - Household is \$500 plus \$250 for each additional
- **Associate Membership** entitles you to all programs except volunteer-provided services
  - Individual and household fee is \$500
  - \$375 of fee treated as charitable contribution for general support of ANV and may be tax deductible
