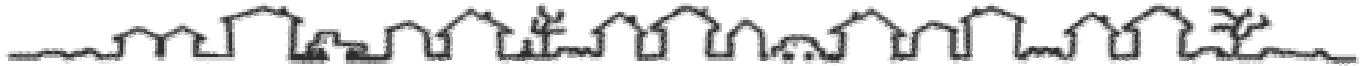


Bluemont Commercial District Planning Charrette

The charrette will focus on Wilson Boulevard between George Mason Drive and Jefferson Street, and will address commercial revitalization, redevelopment, beautification, traffic calming and pedestrian safety. This area is expected to become intensely impacted in the near term as development pressure shifts westward from Ballston.

Participants will include residents, business owners, developers and county staff. The inclusion of many points of view and expertise will result in well-rounded and realistic proposals, with stakeholders satisfied that they were able to contribute. The objective is to produce a comprehensive vision of how the neighborhood would like to see this area evolve, and to leave with specific planning objectives that the neighborhood can pursue to attain that vision.

The meeting will be held in the Multi-Purpose Room of Arlington Traditional School, located at 855 North Edison Street (one block north of Wilson
