Peck/Staples SPRC Meeting Set for January 8

Monday, January 8, 2007, 7 pm 4301 Wilson Boulevard (NRECA building at Wilson and Taylor)

The first Peck/Staples Site Plan Review Committee (SPRC) on will be held on Monday, January 8, 2007, 7 pm, at the National Rural Electric Cooperative Association (NRECA) building at the corner of N. Taylor Street. (Free parking is available in the underground garage via access on N. Taylor St.) This meeting will be residents' first opportunity to speak directly to the committee members who will make recom-

mendations about this plan to the County Board. Despite having met with and receiving feedback from BCA on six previous occasions, JBG has refused to address neighborhood concerns regarding traffic, parking, height, etc., until after the SPRC meetings have begun. The more Bluemont residents who attend the January 8 meeting, the more likely it will be that our concerns are addressed. (And if there isn't sufficient community input, JBG won't have to make any changes to its plans.)
